
UK - FURNITURE MOVING SYSTEM - 90766

Assembly instructions:

Align arrows on both the upper and lower parts of the lifter (figure A)

Spring both spring locks (figure B) and interlock both parts of the lifter. You will hear a click once it's in place. Unit is now assembled and ready for use.



How to use furniture lifter:

To insert the lifter under the leg or bottom of items that sit directly on carpet or the floor, remove the black plastic tip cover on the lifter to reveal the beveled edge. This will make inserting the tip of the lifter between the furniture and the carpet or floor easier (figure C).

Caution: using the lifter without the cap on floor such as wood or linoleum can cause damage to the floor. **Note**: to insert the lifter under the leg or bottoms of items that don't sit directly on the carpet or floor, keep the black plastic tip cover on the lifter.


Position the lifter at an angle under the item you are lifting (FigureD). Using this placement will help the tip of the lifter make contact across the most solid part of the item. Be sure furniture lifter is assembled properly before use.

How to use furniture slides:

Slightly lift furniture using the furniture lifter and place one furniture slide foam side up under each corner or the item to the moved. Simply slide the item to move it (figure E & F). When finished, remove slides and store until next use.

Helpful hints

- To use on hard surface floor such as wood, tile and linoleum: place blue felt side down.
- To use on carpets: place blue felt side up.
- The black plastic tip cover on the furniture lifter is intended to decrease the likelihood of damage when lifting wood furniture or other delicate objects.
 Always use the black plastic tip when possible to reduce the risk of damage.
- The furniture lifter is made with an adjustable pivot point. Moving the pivot point as close to the tip as possible gives you the most lifting power. However, some furniture is designed with the frame on the floor and moving the pivot point back will give you the ability to pivot the lifter high enough to lift these items off the floor.







- Be sure your floor and slides are clean prior to use. Small debris such as soil, sand, pebbles etc., may cause damage to the floor surface.
- Do not use on newly finished floors until the floor is completely cured, approximately 4-6 weeks or refer to your floor manufacturer's recommendations for compatibility.
- Do not use on rough concrete, this will damage the mover.
